## **Code of Ethics for Coaches**

## **Spokane Girls' Fastpitch Softball Association**

(Effective November 9, 1995)

Coaches in the Spokane Girls' Fastpitch Softball Association shall conduct themselves in accordance with the following Code of Ethics:

- 1. Coaches will treat each player, opposing coach, umpire, and parent with respect and dignity.
- 2. Coaches will place the physical well-being of their players ahead of any personal desire to win.
- 3. Coaches promise to review and practice the prescribed SGFSA first aid policy in treating injuries of their players.
- 4. Coaches will learn the fundamental skills, teaching and evaluation techniques, and strategies of fastpitch softball.
- 5. Coaches will do their best to organize practices that are rewarding and challenging for all of their players.
- 6. Coaches will insure that they are knowledgeable in the ASA Rules and that they teach those rules to their players.
- 7. Coaches will uphold the authority of umpires who are assigned to the games in which they coach.
- 8. Coaches will learn the strengths and weaknesses of their players so that they can place them into situations where they best benefit the team and improve their skill level.
- 9. Coaches will strive to utilize positive correctional approaches when dealing with players making mental or physical errors.
- 10. Coaches will lead, by example, in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all of their players.
- 11. Coaches will abide by the SGFSA Recruiting and Pickup Player Policy.
